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## PREFACE

The 2011 population estimates contained on the following tables were developed from population estimates released by the University of Louisville, Kentucky State Data Center and the US Census Bureau.

Labor force estimates for 2011 were produced based on several data sources. The Local Area Unemployment Statistics (LAUS) staff developed the county labor force estimates for sex and race based on the 2010 Census of Population and the 2011 Current Population Survey.

The methods used in preparing the county sex and race estimates assume the same relationships that existed in 2010 continue to exist in 2011. This data should be used for Affirmative Actions purposes only. We do not advise comparing the data in this issue with earlier publications.

This report is produced annually by the Research and Statistics Branch under the supervision of Ron Crouch.
