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## PREFACE

The 2013 population estimates contained on the following tables were developed from population estimates released by the University of Louisville, Kentucky State Data Center and the US Census Bureau.

Labor force estimates for 2013 were produced based on several data sources. The Local Area Unemployment Statistics (LAUS) staff developed the county labor force estimates for sex and race based on the 2012 Census of Population and the 2013 Current Population Survey.

The methods used in preparing the county sex and race estimates assume the same relationships that existed in 2012 continue to exist in 2013. This data should be used for Affirmative Actions purposes only. We do not advise comparing the data in this issue with earlier publications.

This report is produced annually by the Workforce Intelligence Branch.

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## OCCUPATIONAL EMPLOYMENT BY RACE AND SEX

Some employers may need additional Affirmative Action Data than that which is listed in this publication. The U.S. Census Bureau released occupational employment by sex and minority status from the *2006-2010 Special EEO Tabulation File*. It provides detailed data on the sex and race/ethnicity for all occupations covered in the 2010 Census. (Please note that occupations with no employment in a specified area, or in instances where disclosure might lead to confidentiality issues, are not listed.)
