

Kentucky Trends in Births by Marital Status, Age and Educational Level

1960 to 2014

Historical birth data from the **Office of Vital Statistics, Department of Public Health, Kentucky Cabinet for Family and Health Services, CHFS**, for the state of Kentucky starting in 1960 shows Kentucky births at 72,018 in 1960 and going down slightly to 67,901 in 1964, the end of the 1946 to 1964 national Baby Boom following World War II. The next year, 1965, births had dropped significantly to 61,392 and reached a low point of 51,422 in 1988 and slowed increased to 59,297 in 2007 before heading to the mid 50,000's from 2010 to 2014, preliminary data, ranging from 53,637 in 2011 to 56,539 in 2014.

In the attached tables and graphs, pages 1 and 2 show the birth trend in graph form from 1960 to 2014 in 10 year segments and also show the growing number of births by decade in unmarried births going from 8.9% in 1970, the first year the data for unmarried mothers was shown to 41.8% in 2014, preliminary data. Additional tables and graphs will show unmarried birth trends for 2000, 2005, 2010, and 2014 including age and education of the mother. These data come from **Table 1I, Resident Live Births by Age, Marital Status, and Education of Mother** produced by the Office of Vital Statistics. They were published on line until 2005 but due to staff reductions the 2010 and 2014 Table 1I was produced by special request from the Office of Vital Statistics. **The data is very useful in understanding birth trends in Kentucky which have and will effect school enrollment and workforce trends for Kentucky now and in the future.**

The line graph on page 3 shows births by **Kentucky Area Development Districts, ADD's**, from 1960 to 2014 for example showing significant birth declines in the Louisville KIPDA ADD from 17,537 in 1960 to 12,433 in 2014 and in the Kentucky River ADD births declining by more than half from 3,511 in 1960 to 1,422 in 2014. Single year data on births by ADD and County, 1960 to 2014, are available at the **Kentucky State Data Center Homepage, www.ksdc.louisville.edu, University of Louisville**, under Data Downloads and then under Vital Statistics.

The tables on page 4 and 5 show numbers and percent of births for total, married and unmarried mothers' births by mother's age for the 4 selected years in five year periods with 2014 being the latest available birth data. The Table 1I shows additional ages of Under 15, 128 in 2000 down to 44 in 2014; 40-44, 743 in 2000 up to 850 in 2014; 45 and Over, 26 in 2000 up to 53 in 2014; as these 3 age cohorts have small numbers compared to the other 5 age cohorts, and Unknown, 29 in 2000 but up to 2,164 or 3.8% of births in 2014; but are not shown in the attached tables and graphs the **Workforce Intelligence Branch, Office of Employment and Training, OET, Kentucky Education and Workforce Development Cabinet** produced for this report. The 2000 and 2005 Table 1I is available on line at the Kentucky Office of Vital Statistics or from the Workforce Intelligence Branch, OET, and the 2010 and 2014 Table 1I produced by Kentucky Vital Statistics but not on line is available from the Workforce Intelligence Branch, OET, as well. Also the tables on pages 6 and 7 show educational attainment of birth mothers but the 2000 Table 1I only shows 13 Years+ which would be college and above while the 2005, 2010, and 2014 Table 1I shows "Some College" and "College Degree". Therefore the tables on page 6 and 7 show "Some

College and Above” but not “College Degree”. The graph and table on page 15 shows data for “Some College” and also “College Degree” for 2014.

Pages 4 and 5 show the largest age grouping of births from 2000 to 2005 was to mothers, ages 20 to 24, but in 2014, to mothers, ages 25 to 29. It also shows teen births, ages 15 to 19, dropping from 7,721 and 13.8% of all births in 2000 to 4,763 and 8.4% of all births in 2014, a positive. All four years show the majority of births were to women, ages 25 and above, 54.9% in 2000 and 64.0% in 2014 so Kentucky’s birth mothers are getting older, also a positive **However in all age groups unmarried births are going up with the total being 31% in 2000 and in 2014, 41.8%.** For teens, ages 15 to 19, going from 68.0% to 83.1% between 2000 and 2014 and for young women, ages 20 to 24, going from 40.4% in 2000 to 59.7% in 2014. **As the age of the mother increases the percent of unmarried mothers decreases but still is higher within each age group over time for the 4 years shown.**

As mentioned in an earlier paragraph, the tables on pages 6 and 7 show numbers and percent of births for total, married and unmarried mothers births by mother’s education for the 4 selected years in five year periods with 2014 being the latest available birth data. The Tables 1-I also show education by age of the mother not shown in the tables on pages 6 and 7. Tables 6 and 7 show educational levels of mothers going up over the 15 year period; at the lowest for less than high school, 1,898 or 3.4% of births in 2000 dropping to 1,268 or 2.3% of births in 2014 while at the highest for some college or above, 23,144 or 41.3% in 2000 to 30,396 or 54.0% in 2014, the majority of births to mothers with education beyond high school, a positive. In looking at unmarried births, for all education levels, except less than high school, unmarried births increased between 2000 and 2014 but were lower as education levels increased between education levels. Those mothers with some high school went from 5,780 or 57.9% unmarried in 2000 to 4,005 or 70.0% unmarried in 2014 with the number of births going down but the percent of unmarried births going up. Those mothers with a high school degree or GED went from 7,178 or 35.7% unmarried in 2000 to 8,509 or 58.0% unmarried in 2014, a majority in 2014 of mothers with a high school degree or GED being unmarried. Those mother with some college or above went from 7,287 or 14.3% unmarried in 2000 to 8,754 or 28.8% unmarried in 2014, so the significant majority of better educated mothers were married.

The line graphs on pages 8 to 13 show the previous table numbers as line graphs. Page 8 shows age of mother by total and unmarried numbers. Notice as mentioned earlier, 25 to 29 year old mothers accounted for the greatest number of births by age cohort in 2014 while under age 15 barely shows up between 2000 and 2014 and ages 15 to 19 shows a significant decline in birth numbers, both total and unmarried declined between 2000 and 2014, a positive. Page 9 shows education of mother by total and unmarried numbers with significant increases in birth mothers with some college plus and decreases in the numbers with high school or GED and 9th to 12th grade, no diploma, a positive.

The line graphs on pages 10 to 13 show the birth data by age and by education by percent for both total and unmarried on pages 10 and 12, and married and unmarried on page 11 and 13.

The final two pages, 14 and 15 show bar graphs and tables for the latest 2014 birth mothers data including all the age cohorts, Under 15 to 45 and Over as well as Unknown on page 14 and less than 9th grade to a college degree on page 15. Notice for those birth mothers with a college degree, 12,551 births with only 1,050 or 8.4% being unmarried.

Unfortunately the trend data shows a growing number of children at risk with unmarried births rising to 41.8% of total births in Kentucky in 2014 and highly correlated to the age and education of the birth mother. The literature has shown that children born to mothers who are unmarried are in much less stable relationships, more likely to be poor, and the unmarried fathers to be much less likely to be involved in their children's lives. These trends have major impacts on poverty rates for children, their school success, their educational attainment levels, and having a workforce ready for the skills and education needed for today's and tomorrow's workforce.


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
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Kentucky Total and Unmarried Births - 1960-2014








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


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Resident Live Births by Age of Mother: 2000-2014



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
Resident Live Births by Education of Mother: 2000-2014


