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## PREFACE

The 2010 population estimates contained on the following tables were developed from population estimates released by the University of Louisville, Kentucky State Data Center and the US Census Bureau.

Labor force estimates for 2010 were produced based on several data sources. The Local Area Unemployment Statistics (LAUS) staff developed the county labor force estimates for sex and race based on the 2000 Census of Population and the 2010 Current Population Survey.

The methods used in preparing the county sex and race estimates assume the same relationships that existed in 2000 continue to exist in 2010. This data should be used for Affirmative Action purposes only. We do not advise comparing the data in this issue with earlier publications.

This report is produced annually by the Research and Statistics Branch under the supervision of Thomas Bowell. Jonathan MacDonald and Corey Jennings were the primary staff persons involved in the preparation of this report.

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## OCCUPATIONAL EMPLOYMENT BY RACE AND SEX

Some employers may need additional Affirmative Action Data than that which is listed in this publication. The U.S. Census Bureau released occupational employment by sex and minority status from the *2000 Special EEO Tabulation File*. It provides detailed data on the sex and race/ethnicity for 509 occupations covered in the 2000 Census. (Please note that occupations with no employment in a specified area, or in instances where disclosure might lead to confidentiality issues, are not listed.) - Choose the appropriate Occupation table
- Choose the appropriate Education table (if needed)
- Choose the desired Geography (either Residence or Worksite)
- Click on “Next”
- Choose County Sets for Kentucky
- Click on “Next”

Note: Data is not available for every individual county. If the Residence Geography option was chosen, many counties will be grouped with neighboring counties into county sets. There is an optional list below the county sets selection option that provides definitions of each of the county sets. If the Worksite Geography option was chosen, data will only be available for the 15 counties with population of 50,000 or more.
